Erhard Willi Bublitz went home to be with the Lord on October 15, 2024 in Surrey, BC. Erhard was born to parents Emil and Natalie Bublitz in East Prussia, which is now Budry, Poland. He immigrated to Canada in 1954 and settled in the Vancouver area. In 1961, he returned to Germany where he married the love of his life Gerhilde Rosemarie. He came back to Canada and made his career as a machinist and welder. A loving father and a man of great faith, he raised a family of three children. He loved music and played the violin and the harmonica as well as singing in the church choir. Erhard was treasurer of his church for many years.
