A long time resident of Dewdney, Margaret passed away at TRIM on July 20, 2021 having just celebrated her 91st birthday.

Margaret will be missed by her family, sons, Earl (Cyndie), Allan (Janet), Gordon (Wendy) and daughter Valerie Olson.

She was "Grandma Farm' to 12 grandchildren, and 16 great grandchildren.
